CIGAR FUN FACTS

- Did you know when Christopher Columbus came to the New World in 1492 he witnessed the natives smoking the leaves of an unfamiliar plant? The natives of South and Central America smoked tobacco wrapped in leaves of local plants – their version of a cigar. Columbus and his crew brought the tobacco back to Spain, and where the cigar industry boomed, creating the modern cigar that we know of today.
- The English term 'cigar' was derived from the Spanish 'cigarro', which in turn is adapted from the Mayan word for tobacco, 'siyar'
- In 1962, just before President John F. Kennedy sanctioned a trade embargo with Cuba, he instructed his secretary to get a hold of as many of his favorite Cuban cigars as he could find.
- The most expensive cigar in the world was made in 2006. The Cohiba Behike (Cohiba 40th Anniversary Edition) USD\$440 a piece and USD\$18,860 for a box. It was also one of the most exclusive. Only 4,000 were made.
- You wouldn't think a cartoon character would be the inspiration of cigar line, but that is exactly where Punch got its name around 1840. The name Punch was taken from an English humor magazine (and a very popular puppet show) The character "Punch" smoked and stogie and repeatedly hit everyone with his club. You may vaguely recall the names "Punch and Judy" as they were seldom apart.
- On April 17, 2010, Cuba most revered tobacco grower, Alejandro Robaina passed away at the age of 91.
